These adaptations of Ravel, Tchaikovsky, Köhler, and coming soon, Paderewski are part of Falls House Press's **Voyage Unlimited Series**, a collection of new transcriptions for flute and string quartet or string trio. The works were premiered in August of 1999 at the National Flute Association Convention in Atlanta by flutist Don Bailey and members of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra, and at the Washington, D.C. convention with the Voyage Unlimited Quartet. Their New York premiere took place in October of 2008 —with Don Bailey and the Attacca Quartet.

Bailey recorded the transcriptions in the Voyage Unlimited Series on VOYAGE (Summit Records). They have garnered critical acclaim and worldwide airplay, but they have not been available for public performance until now.

Orchestrated by the esteemed Polish pianist Adam Manijak, Bailey's inspired series has helped create an exciting new chapter in repertoire for flute and string ensembles.
